

Fur Sewing Workshop with "Diane Wirth"

*** This workshop will have no time limit ***

This workshop is intended to be as hands on as a person wants to make it. Diane plans on showing how to make a fur pillow from small fur remnants. Also she will teach how to lay out a pattern so the fur flows the proper way. How to cut out the pieces without damaging the fur. The whip stitch and any other question that come up. So bring your tanned pelts or remnants and any pattern or tools you may want to use. There will be a limited amount of fur remnants available to practice on. This workshop will be held outside in the gazebo, so choose a seat in the shade or in the sun, its your choice. A wading pool will be set up nearby for those young children.
