WHAT'S NEW IN 2020-2021

As expected, our local recreation program has now merged with Hancock Natural Resource Group's global alternative land use website. You must purchase permits at www.hancockrecreation.com. All former, current, and new customers will be required to setup a new account. Once your account is created, you will be able to access your account and reprint your permit at any time. The new website will accept your bank cards directly and we will no longer be utilizing paypal. We will appreciate your patience as we navigate a new system but are excited for a more user friendly and advanced website to include easy communications with customers and streamlined payment process.

Any individual 18 years and older is required to purchase their own permit. For a spouse to ride along, they are required to have their own permit. Children 17 and under may recreate under the adult permit but they **MUST** be accompanied by the adult permit holder when accessing the property. KAPOWSIN: \$300

INDIVIDUAL MOTORIZED PERMIT

1200 PERMITS AVAILABLE

Permit is valid for ONE adult and dependent children 17 years and younger. Spouses and children 18+ are required to have their own permit.

- Access is valid from April 1, 2020 – March 30, 2021
- Big game and small game hunting per WDFW rules and regulations (with the exception of additional HFM regulations for deer and elk hunting).
- Camping in designated camp areas with camping hangtag
- Collection of up to 5 cords of firewood – firewood is to be properly cut and tagged per recreation rules
- Permits purchased by 9:00am on May 11, 2020 will be entered into the bull elk drawing. One permit = one entry.
- Kapowsin will draw 3 Muzzleloaders permit holders, 3 Archery permit holders, and 5 Modern Firearm permit holders for the elk draw.
- Antlerless deer harvest is allowed if drawn from the WDFW youth, disabled, and 65 & over special permit categories only. No general season antlerless deer

WHITE RIVER: \$175

INDIVIDUAL MOTORIZED PERMIT

400 PERMITS AVAILABLE

Permit is valid for ONE adult and dependent children 17 years and younger. Spouses and children 18+ are required to have their own permit.

- Access is valid from April 1, 2020 – March 30, 2021
- **Motorized Access is restricted from January 1 – March 30. You may still enter via non-motorized access with your current permit.
- Big game and small game hunting per WDFW rules and regulations (with the exception of additional HFM regulations for deer and elk hunting).
- Camping in designated camp areas with camping hangtag
- Collection of up to 3 cords of firewood – firewood is to be properly cut and tagged per recreation rules

EATONVILLE: \$250

INDIVIDUAL MOTORIZED PERMIT

200 PERMITS AVAILABLE

Permit is valid for ONE adult and dependent children 17 years and younger. Spouses and children 18+ are required to have their own permit.

- Access is valid from April 1, 2020 – March 30, 2021
- Big game and small game hunting per WDFW rules and regulations (with the exception of additional HFM regulations for deer and elk hunting).
- Camping in designated camp areas with camping hangtag
- Collection of up to 3 cords of firewood – firewood is to be properly cut and tagged per recreation rules
- Permits purchased by 9:00am on May 11, 2020 will be entered into the bull elk drawing. One permit = one entry.
- Eatonville will draw 1 permit holder for the elk draw.
- Antlerless deer harvest is allowed if drawn from the WDFW youth, disabled, and 65 & over special permit categories only. No general season antlerless deer harvest allowed.

WHITE RIVER

NON-MOTORIZED: \$45.00 (200 AVAILABLE)

Permit is valid for ONE adult and dependent children 17 years and younger. Spouses and children 18+ are required to have their own permit.

- Access is valid from April 1, 2020 – March 30, 2021
- Big game and small game hunting per WDFW rules and regulations (with the exception of additional HFM regulations for deer and elk hunting).
- You must print one copy of your permit and keep on your person, and one copy to leave on your vehicle dash
- Non-motorized permit does not allow access to ride in a motorized permit holder's vehicle

IMPORTANT REMINDERS!

1. Every motorized access point has a check in kiosk – you are **REQUIRED** to sign in every individual in your vehicle, every time you enter the forest. In the case of an emergency we must know how many individuals are in the forest and a general location of where we could find you! Not signing in **WILL** result in the privileges of your permit being revoked.
2. Pack it in, Pack it out! Please pick up your trash, and remove all equipment prior to the end of the permit term, including game cameras, tree stands, etc.
3. We **WILL** close in extreme fire or storm danger. This is for **YOUR SAFETY!** We follow the DNR's industrial fire protection levels and monitor moisture levels in the forest.
4. When purchasing your permit, you are required to accept the terms of our rules and regulations before continuing to payment, not being aware of the rules and not following the rules may result in your permit privileges being revoked. Recreation rules are mailed in your packet and always available online for review. Firewood - all firewood unit maps will list the legal description (section, township, range). You can then match that to the large map received in your packet to easily find units. We also highly suggest downloading the smartphone app called Avenza Maps and importing the recreation map PDF from the website.
5. The new permit structure does **NOT** allow for your spouse to ride-along without their own permit under any circumstance.

MEET THE RECREATION STAFF:

Nate Hayden – North Cascades Area Manager, Hancock Forest Management - has been with HFM since 2014 as a roads engineer and has been the area manager since 2018. Nate oversees the recreation program and works closely with the neighboring landowners whose property is included in the program.

Heather Nunnally – Administrative Assistant, Hancock Forest Management – has been with the company since 2016. Heather processes permit packages and carries the main customer service role for the recreation program.

Israel Joseph – Property Monitor, White River tree farm – upon returning from the United States Marine Corp, Izy began patrolling as a property monitor in 2014.

Dennis Flowers – Property Monitor, Kapowsin & Eatonville tree farms – after 22 years as a state parks manager and 14 years as a Washington Dept of Fish & Wildlife officer, Dennis retired and recently joined our property monitor team in 2019.




Step 1: The first thing you will want to do is create an account. You will select register at the top of the home page and be directed to the screen below.

***The password protection is very strict** and will not allow you to use any dictionary words which can make creating a password slightly difficult – we suggest using symbols in place of letters and writing your password down in a safe and secure place, **a sample password would be Pa\$\$w0rd1\$\$.**


****Two factor authentication** is another security measure to sign in. If you opt in (check the box) you will be required to finish setting it up and will not be able to bypass the process.




Step 2: This is what your account will look like when logged in. You can edit your contact info and vehicle, or send us a message. The office responsible will be “Kapowsin”. If you click on “My Licenses” you can see your permit, “My Bids” will not apply to our local program. “Members” is where you will list your number of children.




Step 3: After signed in you will click on “MAP” or redirect to the home page, the first screen will be an overview map, in the first search field select “STATE” and then scroll down and select Washington.




Step 4: Once WA is selected, our 4 permits will show up – Kapowsin, Eatonville, White River – Non-Motorized, White River – Motorized. To purchase, select “Learn More” on the desired property.



Step 5: Other areas within our company allow for bidding, since we do not, you will select “License Now” to purchase your permit.



Step 6: This screen will confirm your purchase, (only for Kapowsin and Eatonville will you select a weapon preference). You must scroll thru the terms of agreement and TYPE the word “agree” to continue.



Step 6: This is the final page to complete your purchase and where you will enter in your payment method. NO MORE PAYPAL!
