- **All Hunters must be drawn for a tag** with Washington State Fish and Wildlife **to hunt Big Game** unless they are certified Master Hunter. Information: <https://wdfw.wa.gov/hunting/masterhunter/>

- **Register Your Firearm:** at YTC Police Department Bldg. 159
BRING IN ON PAPER the **Make, Model, Serial #, Caliber/Gauge, Color/Finish, Barrel Length and Overall Length** of your firearm. *Do not bring in the actual physical firearm*). When transporting firearms, make sure it is *unloaded and secured* in a carrying case when not in use.

- **WEAR HUNTER ORANGE** at least 400 Sq. inches at all times while down range
- Call HUNTER HOTLINE after 8:30PM the day before to **find out what training areas are open** for the next day.
- **If you are returning after dusk** call the police desk to let them know so they do not come looking for you.
- You are allowed on base 2 hours before daylight and 2 hours after daylight.
- No outdoor rec-cards are required for use of the Palouse to Cascades Trail (P2C) or for use of the Juvenile Fishing Pond by youth 15 years & younger
- No mountain biking or horseback riding down range – restricted to P2C.
- **Seibert Stake Areas** are **OFF LIMITS** to all vehicles.
